

DUDICH on or about January 21, 2017 at Geauga County, Ohio, did subject to division (B)(2) of this section, discharge a firearm on a lawn, park, pleasure ground, orchard, or other ground appurtenant to a schoolhouse, church, or inhabited dwelling, the property of another, or a charitable institution, contrary to and in violation of R.C. 2923.162(A)(2), Discharge of a Firearm on or near Prohibited Premises, a misdemeanor of the fourth degree.
