YOU ARE HEREBY SUMMONED AND ORDERED to appear in Judge Timothy J. Grendell's courtroom on **AUGUST 14, 2017 at 12:00PM** to show cause why you should not be held in Contempt of Court for failure to comply with the Court's order filed on July 26, 2017

You are notified as follows:

- (1) If you fail to appear a warrant for your arrest may be issued.
- (2) You have a right to counsel or, if indigent, a right to court appointed counsel; but you must apply for court appointed counsel within three (3) business days after receipt of this summons.
- (3) At the time of hearing, the Court may refuse to grant a continuance to enable you to obtain counsel if you fail to make a good faith effort to retain counsel or a public defender before the hearing.
- (4) At the time of the hearing the court may grant limited driving privileges pursuant to your request, if your driver's license was suspended based on a notice as from a child support agency that you are in default or noncompliance under a child support order and if you request is accompanied by a recent noncertified copy of a driver's abstract from the Registrar of Motor Vehicles and a copy of your proof of financial responsibility.
- (5) If you are found guilty in this case, you may be punished as follows:
 - (a) For a first offense, a jail sentence of thirty (30) days and/or a fine of up to Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$250.00).
 - (b) For a second offense, a jail sentence of sixty (60) days and/or a fine of up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
 - (c) For a third offense, a jail sentence of ninety (90)

days and/or a fine of up to One Thousand Dollars
(\$1,000.00).



 - (b) For a second offense, a jail sentence of sixty (60) days and/or a fine of up to Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
 - (c) For a third offense, a jail sentence of ninety (90)

days and/or a fine of up to One Thousand Dollars
(\$1,000.00).


