

I, Bryan T. Kostura, Special Prosecuting Attorney of Geauga County, says by way of information that, FRANK J. GLIHA, 11281 Highland View Drive, Chardon, Ohio, 44024, SSN: XXX-XX-5147, DOB: 09-19-1946, the Defendant, on or about January 8, 2013, did in this County violate R.C. 2921.44(E), in that said defendant

being a public servant did recklessly fail to perform a duty expressly imposed by law with respect to the public servant's office, or recklessly do any act expressly forbidden by law with respect to the public servant's office, to-wit: purchase any product, repair, service, improvement or maintenance at a cost in excess of \$50,000, shall be obtained through competitive bidding, as defined in section 307.86 of the Revised Code, contrary to and in violation of R.C. 2921.44(E), Dereliction of Duty, a misdemeanor of the second degree.

SECOND COUNT: The defendant, FRANK J. GLIHA, on or about February 12, 2014 at Geauga County, Ohio, being a public servant did recklessly fail to perform a duty expressly imposed by law with respect to the public servant's office, or recklessly do any act expressly forbidden by law with respect to the public servant's office, to-wit: purchase any product, repair, service, improvement or maintenance at a cost in excess of \$50,000, shall be obtained through competitive bidding, as defined in section 307.86 of the Revised Code, contrary to and in violation of R.C. 2921.44(E), Dereliction of Duty, a misdemeanor of the second degree.

THIRD COUNT: The defendant, FRANK J. GLIHA, on or between July 11, 2011 - April 11, 2017, in a continuing course of criminal conduct, at Geauga County, Ohio, being a public servant did recklessly fail to perform a duty expressly imposed by law with respect to the public servant's office, or recklessly do any act expressly forbidden by law with respect to the public servant's office, to-wit: no county office shall purchase, lease, operate or contract for the use of any equipment, software, services without prior approval of the Automatic Data Processing Board, as defined in section 307.847(A) of the Revised Code, contrary to and in violation of R.C. 2921.44(E), Dereliction of Duty, a misdemeanor of the second degree.

FOURTH COUNT: The defendant, FRANK J. GLIHA, on or between October 15, 2012 – April 3, 2018, in a continuing course of criminal conduct, at Geauga County, Ohio, being a public servant did recklessly fail to perform a duty expressly imposed by law with respect to the public servant's office, or recklessly do any act expressly forbidden by law with respect to the public servant's office, to-wit: distribute annual payments held in the "undivided public housing fund" for fiscal year 2000 after discovery, which shall be distributed to the taxing subdivisions levying taxes in the subdivisions in which the property is located, in the same proportions in which the current general property tax is distributed as defined in section 3735.35 of the Revised Code, contrary to and in violation of R.C. 2921.44(E), Dereliction of Duty, a misdemeanor of the second degree.

FIFTH COUNT: The defendant, FRANK J. GLIHA, on or between July 11, 2011 – ^{April 3, 2018} ~~present~~, in a continuing course of criminal conduct, at Geauga County, Ohio, being a public servant did recklessly fail to perform a duty expressly imposed by law with respect to the public servant's office, or recklessly do any act expressly forbidden by law with respect to the public servant's office, to-wit: all public officials are responsible for the design and operation of a system of internal controls that is adequate to provide reasonable assurance regarding the achievement of objectives for their respective public offices in certain categories as defined in section 117-2-01 of the Ohio Administrative Code, contrary to and in violation of R.C. 2921.44(E), Dereliction of Duty, a misdemeanor of the second degree.

Contrary to section 2921.44 of the Revised Code of Ohio, and against the peace and dignity of the State of Ohio.

WAIVER OF PROSECUTION BY INDICTMENT


