

having knowledge of an accident or collision with persons or property upon any of the public roads or highways due to his driving or operation thereon of a motor vehicle, failed to immediately stop his motor vehicle at the scene of the accident or collision and failed to remain at the scene of the accident or collision until he had given his name and address and the name and address of the owner of the motor vehicle, together with the registered number of that motor vehicle, to-wit: the collision resulted in the death of Tyler Davis and the offender knew the collision resulted in the death of a person, contrary to and in violation of R.C. 4549.02(A)(1)(B)(3)(b), Failure to Stop After an Accident, a felony of the second degree.

SECOND COUNT: The Grand Jurors further find and present that GEORGE J. GASPARE on or about November 12, 2022 in Geauga County, Ohio, having knowledge of an accident or collision with persons or property upon any of the public roads or highways due to his driving or operation thereon of a motor vehicle, failed to immediately stop his motor vehicle at the scene of the accident or collision and failed to remain at the scene of the accident or collision until he had given his name and address and the name and address of the owner of the motor vehicle, together with the registered number of that motor vehicle, to-wit: the collision resulted in the death of Tyler Davis, contrary to and in violation of R.C. 4549.02(A)(1)(B)(3)(a), Failure to Stop After an Accident, a felony of the third degree.

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FOURTH COUNT: The Grand Jurors further find and present that GEORGE J. GASPARE on or about November 12, 2022 in Geauga County, Ohio, knowing that an official proceeding or investigation is in progress, or is about to be or likely to be instituted, did alter, destroy, conceal, or remove any record, document, or thing, with purpose to impair its value or availability as evidence in such proceeding or investigation, contrary to and in violation of R.C. 2921.12(A)(1), Tampering with Evidence, a felony of the third degree.

FIFTH COUNT: The Grand Jurors further find and present that GEORGE J. GASPARE on or about November 12, 2022 in Geauga County, Ohio, knowing that an official proceeding or investigation is in progress, or is about to be or likely to be instituted, did alter, destroy, conceal, or remove any record, document, or thing, with purpose to impair its value or availability as evidence in such proceeding or investigation, contrary to and in violation of R.C. 2921.12(A)(1), Tampering with Evidence, a felony of the third degree.


SIXTH COUNT: The Grand Jurors further find and present that GEORGE J. GASPARE on or about November 12, 2022 in Geauga County, Ohio, while operating or participating in the operation of a motor vehicle, did cause the death of another, recklessly, contrary to and in violation of R.C. 2903.06(A)(2)(a), Aggravated Vehicular Homicide, a felony of the third degree.

SEVENTH COUNT: The Grand Jurors further find and present that GEORGE J. GASPARE on or about November 12, 2022 in Geauga County, Ohio, while operating or participating in the operation of a motor vehicle, did cause the death of another, negligently, contrary to and in violation of R.C. 2903.06(A)(3)(a), Vehicular Homicide, a misdemeanor of the first degree.




